



## About Paul Bordeleau

**Paul Bordeleau** “*Mr. Sullivan*”, *composer and playwright* – has been in show business since his first radio show on WLOL in the 1930’s. He attended Boston University for his Doctoral studies in music education, and subsequently founded theatre groups, youth bands, Bordeleau Keyboard Studios (in 1973: [BordeleauKeyboardStudios.org](http://BordeleauKeyboardStudios.org)), has been a school music educator, and performed as pianist, church organist, entertainer and TV personality. Over the past 8+ decades, he's played in 37 states and 11 countries, for audiences as small as a house party and as large as 10,000 people filling the International Rotary Convention halls. He also traveled internationally for 15 years as music director for Rotary International, and has performed for Presidents Ronald Reagan, George Bush Senior, and Gerald Ford.

Paul also produced the *Paul Bordeleau Musical Show* on BCTV; from 2004 to 2018 and has produced over 100 shows.

But wait – there’s more! Mr. Bordeleau also is a published author of the book *Mysteries of Music Education* (Kindle/Amazon). Since Paul wrote the book, script and music for *Uncle Mort’s Funeral*, he couldn’t resist getting up onstage and animating the character of Mr. Sullivan.

Paul is also a WWII D-Day veteran, (Army, 246<sup>th</sup> Signal Corps Company) and was honored to be invited to West Point to record his WWII story for the library archives. He was also honored to join Honor Flight New England to Washington, DC.
